Legislation on data processing

The data controller data processing **of the University of Debrecen** is subject to the following legal provisions:

- Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (GDPR).

- Act CXII of 2011 on Informational Self-Determination and Freedom of Information

- Act CCIV of 2011 on National Higher Education

Data processing by the controller

Presentation and purpose of data processing:

University Day is all about togetherness and fun. This year we can welcome the new school year together again in the framework of a gigantic opening event hosted by Nagyerdei Stadium.

To ensure that university citizens do not miss the unique stadium show, the University sends a separate short text message (SMS) to its citizens about the event.

Scope of processed data: name and phone number of student, employee.

Legal basis for data processing: Article 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR: (f) processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the controller or by a third party, unless such interests are overridden by the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject which require protection of personal data, in particular where the data subject is a child.

Duration of data processing: the data will be processed by the University of Debrecen until the messages are sent.

<u>Persons with access</u>: The data may be accessed by the staff responsible for organizing, coordinating and performing the event, who are bound by confidentiality and legal responsibility.

Data transfer: Personal data will not be transferred outside your organization

Right to information

In accordance with Article 15 (1) of the GDPR, the data subject may request information **about the personal data processed by** the University of Debrecen.

Right to request a copy

Pursuant to Article 15 (3) to (4) of the GDPR, the data subject may request a copy of the personal data processed by the University of Debrecen.

Right to rectification

Pursuant to Art. 16 GDPR, we will amend and clarify your personal data in accordance with your request.

Right to object

The data subject, on grounds relating to his or her particular situation, shall have the right to object, at any time, to processing of personal data concerning him or her which is based on point (e) or (f) of Article 6(1), including profiling based on those provisions. In that case, the controller shall no longer process the personal data unless the controller demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.

Right to restriction

The data subject may request restriction of processing in the following cases:

- if you dispute the accuracy of the personal data, we will restrict the processing until **the accuracy of the personal data is verified by the** University of Debrecen;

- the processing is unlawful and the data subject opposes the erasure of the data and requests the restriction of their use instead;

- the **University of Debrecen as** data controller no longer needs the personal data, but the data subject requires them for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims; or

- If you exercise your right to object, we will limit data processing to the period during which we examine the lawfulness of your request.

Enforcement options

If the data subject considers that the data processing of the **University of Debrecen** does not comply with the legal requirements, he or she may initiate proceedings at the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (postal address: 1363 Budapest, Pf.: 9., e-mail address: ugyfelszolgalat@naih.hu) or turn to court.
